

AGENCY WISH LIST 2010

Many nonprofit organizations rely on "in-kind" donations of equipment and supplies. If you have these items to spare at your home or office, please consider sharing them with the agencies listed. Alzheimer's Association (599-1159): general office supplies, computers, laser color printer.

American Cancer Society (296-8155): general office supplies, paper for the copier, desktop printer, computer.

American Red Cross (598-9500): cleaning supplies, office supplies, canteen supplies (paper cups and plates, napkins, cookies, soda, juice, bottled water, coffee).

Animal Friends of North Central West Virginia (290-4PET): clumping cat litter, pet beds, pet toys, cleaning supplies, bleach, printer paper, heavy duty garbage bags, house training pads (AKA-puppy pee pads), long-lasting dog chew treats (raw hide, bones, soup bones, greenies).

Arts Monongahela (291-6720): general office supplies, file cabinets, PA system, furniture.

Bartlett House Homeless Shelter (292-0101): ice machine, extra large Pyrex type microwaveable bowls, coffee, filters, sugar, coffee creamer, Styrofoam plates/bowls, plastic eating utensils, Ziplock storage and freezer bags quart and gallon size, Ziplock sandwich bags, evaporated milk (canned milk), "Cream of" soups (chicken, mushroom, celery), canned chicken and beef broth, catsup, vinegar, spices, complete pancake mix, muffin mixes, cake mixes, baking/biscuit mixes, salad dressings (ranch, italian), powdered drink mixes (Kool-Aid, Tang, Country Time etc.), first aid supplies, (Band-aids, disinfectant etc.), double edged disposable razors, shampoo (hotel minis), towels, laundry soap, household cleaning products (all types), a van or SUV to transport food and other donations.

Big Brothers/Big Sisters (983-2383): general office supplies, tickets to events (cultural, athletic, etc.) for kids, backpacks, school supplies, ink cartridges, used cell phones, individual packaged snacks, copy paper.

Boy Scouts (296-6266): computer paper, file folders, calculators, TV/VCR unit, bulletin board, flag pole, fencing, copy paper, general office supplies, wall mount for TV.

Caritas (985-0021): TV/VCR combo, general office supplies, cleaning products (esp. bleach), paper towels, toilet paper, rubber/vinyl gloves, personal care items, detergent, nutritional supplements.

Casa for Kids (599-1087): postage stamps, copy paper, pens, other office supplies.

Christian Help (296-0221): clothing and accessories for women's career clothing closet, hosiery, non-perishable food items, household items.

COMPEER (296-6091): blue 2-pocket folders, tickets to local events (movies, etc.), locking filing cabinet, file folders, address labels, paper cutter, laminator, professional display board, dry-erase board, rubber stamps (copy, sent, etc.), 3-ring binders, jump drive (travel drive), blank birthday cards, gift cards to book stores, copy paper, 3-fold brochure paper, any office organizers (shelves, desktop organizers).

Connecting Link (296-3300): copier, TV/DVD combo, office chairs, copy paper, plain paper fax machine, various office supplies (i.e. ink cartridges, pens, paper clips, binder clips, etc.).

Core Community Center (879-5656): maintenance supplies, cooking pots, utensils, baking pans, kitchen supplies.

CRISS CROSS (291-6819): paper, pens and pencils, staples, highlighters, computer/copy paper, Kitchen Supplies (coffee, utensils, etc.).

Girl Scouts (983-2429): projector for laptop, laser color printer, portable TV w/DVD, portable CD player, craft supplies, scissors, kids paint brushes, art supplies, poster board, digital cameras, board games, sports equipment, outdoor games, storage totes, flower seeds, 1" view binders.

Head Start/Early Head Start (291-9330): child friendly computers and appropriate software, tissues, crayons, children's gloves, backpacks, children's books (ages 0-5), art paper (construction, printer, unlined, etc).

Hospice Care Corporation (1800-350-1161): white copy paper, colored copy paper, ink pens, staples, pencils, markers, post-it notes.

In Touch and Concerned (296-6109): new full size office copier and display board, postage stamps, birthday, get well, thinking of you, and condolence cards, office supplies.

Literacy Volunteers (296-3400): copy paper, office supplies: blue ink pens, paper clips, etc., desks, postage stamps, low level books: math books, reading books, dictionaries, envelopes, calculators, ink (Hp 17, 19,21,901, Q6000a, q6001A, Q6002A, Q6003A; Brother Toner TN580; Lexmark 17, 27), desk chairs, chair mats, wrist cushions for mouse and keyboard, multi-tap phones.

Mental Health Association (292-0525): general office supplies, craft supplies, trinkets for Bingo prizes, videotapes, coffee/creamer/sugar, paper products (plates, cups, napkins, paper towels), personal hygiene products (small ones from hotels work well), water bottles, socks.

Positive Spin (599-1791): cell phones and service, printing and sign making services, any bike, any condition (even parts are OK), bike parts-tubes and tires (especially 26'x 1 and 3/8'), brake pads.

Preston County Sheltered Workshop (864-6446): small backhoe.

Rape and Domestic Violence Information Center (292-5100): disposable diapers, pajamas and nightgowns for women and children, paper products, kitchen items (dishes, pots, pans, etc.), cleaning products, hair brushes, children's videos, umbrellas, deck furniture.

Raymond Wolfe Center (329-3644): tall 2 door filing cabinet, general office supplies, cleaning supplies, personal care items, easy-to-read books and magazines.

Rock Forge Neighborhood House (292-3286): storage shed, Kitchen Aid commercial size mixer, commercial-grade playground equipment, plastic covers for computer monitors, keyboards, and other electronic equipment, kitchen supplies (commercial grade), art and craft supplies, new or like-new toys and games for children ages 18 months-6th grade, sports equipment, healthy snacks, other nutritious food (perishable or non-perishable), personal care supplies, baby food and supplies, pet food and supplies, paper products, office supplies, grass seed, flower, fruit, and vegetable seedlings/seeds, potting soil.
